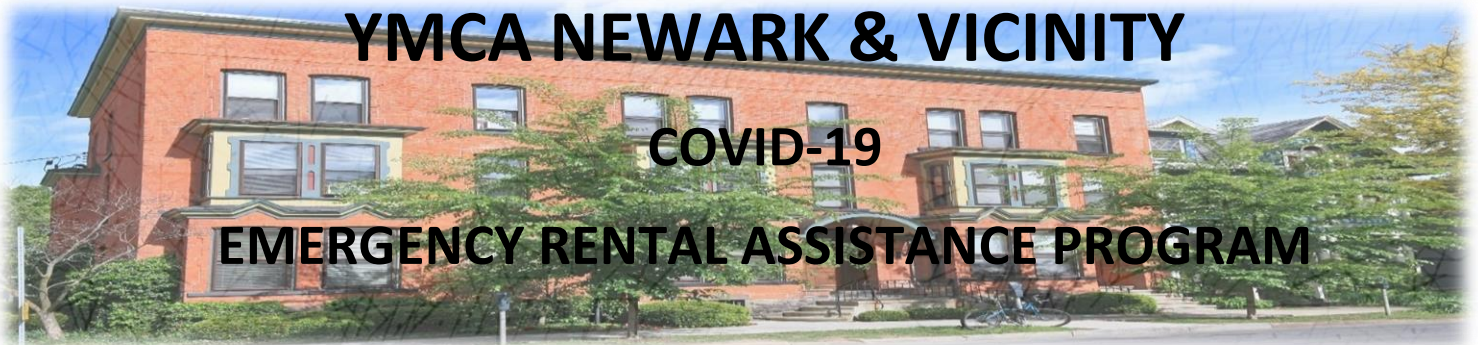

Applications are now available

- ❖ Must be an Essex County Resident
- ❖ Tenants and Landlords may apply.
- ❖ Assistance will be granted on a first, first served basis.
- ❖ Income for eligible applicant must be at or under 80 percent of the Area Medium Income (AMI) set by HUD.
- ❖ Applicants must supply the following:
 - Identification of head of household
 - Social Security Cards (for all household members)
 - Must provide income information for all those in the household older than 18 (i.e., pay stubs, Social Security 2021 benefit letter, Unemployment benefit letter within the last 60 days, Child Support Payment & bank statements)
 - Evidence of Financial Hardship either directly or indirectly due to the COVID-19 outbreak, such as reduction in income. (Documents such as lay-off, termination or furlough letter from employer; unemployment letter dated on or after 3/13/20.)
 - Proof of current lease
 - Notice of rent arrears issued by the property owners, rental statement reflecting arrearages due or eviction notice.
 - Other documents to support COVID Hardship
- ❖ Residents of Section 8 or Public Housing may be eligible to receive assistance for costs not covered by federal assistance or tenants' portion.
